Thurston County USBC Board Member Responsibilities and Expectations

Thurston County USBC's continued success depends on the personal commitment and active involvement of the Board of Directors. Board members are expected to be zealous advocates of Thurston County USBC, enthusiastic communicators and to play an integral role participating and supporting sponsored activities.

All Board Members must:

- Be a Thurston County USBC member in good standing throughout the term
- Attend regularly scheduled Board Meetings (5 per year)*
- Attend the Annual Meeting in the spring
- Actively participate on one or more committees, and be willing to chair or co-chair at least one committee
- Must acknowledge and agree to follow the Association Confidentiality Policy, Leadership Code of Ethics and Conflict of Interest annually.
- SafeSport training and education is a required component of the Register Volunteer Program (RVP) by USBC. All Board members must take, and pass, the SafeSport Education Training annually, and pass a background screening by National Center for Safety Initiatives to obtain the mandatory RVP badge. Failure to pass SafeSport training and education will result in removal from the board.
- Assist with all board sponsored events throughout the year fundraisers, workshops, etc.
- Assist with Board sponsored tournaments help with scorekeeping, brackets, etc.
- Must wear RVP badge at all times when working with Youth
- Maintain a professional appearance at all Board sponsored events and meetings.
- Perform any task assigned by President or Association Manager
- Actively promote the sport of bowling
